The Care Fund grants mortgage or rent relief to families experiencing medical and financial crisis due to a serious illness or injury of their child.

When a family first learns about a medical tragedy involving their child, nothing else seems to matter. Yet, life continues at its hectic pace – parents must work, children have to go to school, bills have to be paid. But when the seriously ill or injured child requires round-the-clock care or life threatening care or years of medical follow-up, the most important factor remains the family home. The center of balance, stability, safety and care.

Medical bankruptcy is the number one cause of foreclosure and eviction.

Many families have little or no savings for a major-medical crisis. What would happen if a family in medical crisis then had to leave their home too? Where can they turn to stay in their home while they care for their child?

After four short years, the Care Fund has served over 450 local Arizona families through the generosity of donors from around the country.



A family grant serves as a bridge to support parents, who often lose their jobs, cars, go into serious debt and lose their credit rating all due to an unexpected child's illness.
