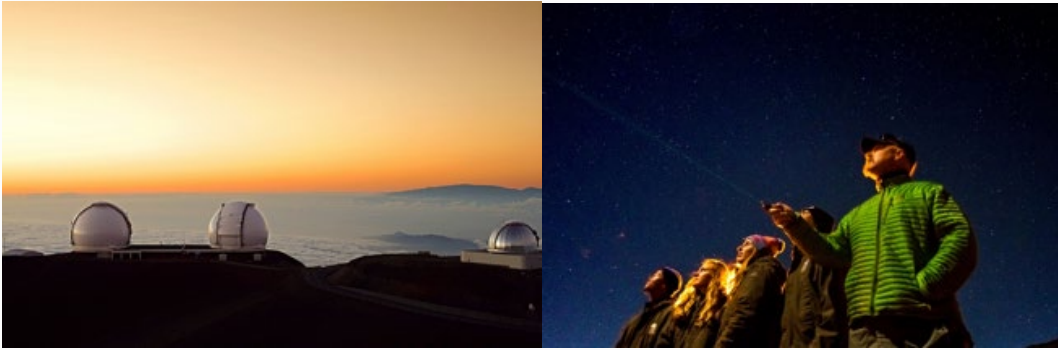

MONDAY or TUESDAY - Summit & Stars - Stargazing on Mauna Kea

Mar 17 or 18, 2025 | 2:45pm – 10:15pm



The summit of Mauna Kea is renowned as the world's greatest astronomical observing site. It is also one of Hawaii's most sacred cultural sites. Begin your tour with a dinner stop featuring a hot, picnic style dinner at The Onizuka Center for International Astronomy Visitor Information Station. After dinner, we make our way to the summit for a sensational sunset. Stand in awe at the top of the world's tallest volcano amidst the largest collection of telescopes on earth and some of the most dramatic scenery you'll ever witness. After, at a more comfortable lower elevation, you'll sip hot cocoa and explore our solar system as your private star-show guide reveals the wonders of the night's sky and Polynesian star lore through our 11in Celestron telescopes. View deep space objects on a state-of-the-art astrophotography digital telescope. Using similar technology as the Hubble Telescope, guests can take home digital photos of deep space objects visible in the night sky during their tour.

Wear warm layers and long pants, closed-toe walking shoes with socks; bring a sweater or jacket. This tour involves travel from sea level to an extremely high altitude of over 13,800 feet (4000 meters) via a four-wheel drive road. **YOU WILL BE COLD.** No one ever believes us, but you will.

You can bring your camera or phone but most photos won't turn out well in the dark.

Parka sizes are due 1 day prior.

Scuba divers note the summit altitude and consult with a divemaster. No Scuba diving within 24 hrs of the tour.

Not recommended for persons with respiratory or heart conditions, or those in poor health. Please consult with a doctor.

Pregnant women and children under 13 yrs not allowed on the summit of Mauna Kea.

It’s a good idea to bring a dry change of clothes to change into after you get out of the water. It can be chilly on the water at night, and you have an air-conditioned ride back on the bus.

For the safety and comfort of other guests and crew members, all guests going in the water **MUST** know how to swim without the assistance of a flotation device. And be comfortable in a snorkel.

Tour our oceanfront salt farm is located on the Kona coastline of Hawaii island - the southern-most island and the largest in the Hawaiian island chain. Kona Sea Salt is the only sea salt in the world made from pure, 900 year-old deep ocean water, rich in natural minerals and flavor. Our salt water is drawn from 2,200 feet below the ocean's surface making it one of the highest quality finishing salts. In addition to gourmet sea salts, as part of the salt making process, we also farm Deep Ocean Minerals as a magnesium supplement, magnesium bath and Nigari - the traditional tofu coagulant.

Kona Salt Farm - Located on 7 acres of oceanfront space on Kona Keāhole Point we harvest Hawaiian Salt from pristine deep ocean waters, 2,200 feet below the surface of the Kona Sea. You will learn about the salt harvesting process and the different kinds of salt variations, how deep seawater is different from surface water, the significance of salt in Hawaiian culture and a brief historical overview of the ancient Hawaiian settlement Ho'ona. Lastly, you will get a chance to taste some of our Kona Pure and Flavored Salts.
